

# Stripchat Affiliate Program: How It Works

Review the Stripchat affiliate program, commission models, traffic quality, payout methods, tracking tools, restrictions, pros, cons, and verification steps.

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**TL;DR** The Stripchat affiliate program, often referenced as StripCash, pays partners for sending qualifying viewer and model traffic to the platform. Commission structures typically include revshare, CPA, and hybrid options, with rates, payout minimums, and traffic restrictions set on the affiliate dashboard. ## What Is the Stripchat Affiliate Program?

**The Stripchat affiliate program is the partner channel that pays media buyers, publishers, and creators for sending qualified adult traffic to the platform. It operates under the StripCash partner brand in most marketing.**

### StripCash and partner branding

StripCash is the partner-facing brand identity for the Stripchat affiliate program. Marketers usually see the program named under StripCash on industry directories, in conference sponsorships, and on affiliate landing pages, while end users see only the Stripchat consumer brand. The split is standard practice in adult affiliate, where the consumer brand stays clean of program internals. Treat StripCash as the operational layer where account management, tracking, and payouts happen.

- StripCash is the partner brand identity
- End users only see the Stripchat consumer brand
- Account management, tracking, and payouts live in the partner portal

### Viewer referral model

The core offer pays partners for viewer referrals: users who land on Stripchat through a tracked link and meet program conditions trigger revenue events. Conditions can include account creation, age verification, and token purchase, depending on the commission type chosen for the offer. Some offers separately pay for model referrals, where the qualifying action is performer signup and verification rather than viewer spend. Verify which actions trigger payouts on the offer page before scaling traffic.

- Viewer referrals tracked by link parameters
- Triggers vary by offer type

- Model referrals usually paid separately

## Adult traffic compliance basics

The program operates in adult and is subject to a stack of compliance rules: 18+ user verification, no incentivized traffic, traffic-source disclosure, and platform-specific rules from ad networks. Adult ad networks and most general-purpose networks treat these rules as table stakes; ignoring them ends in account suspension.

*StripCash is the partner brand. Viewer and model referrals are the headline products.*

## Commission Models to Verify

**The program is described by partners as offering revshare, CPA, and hybrid structures, with the exact terms set per offer and per partner. Verify any figure on the live affiliate dashboard before basing a campaign plan on it.**

### Revshare percentage claims

Revshare offers pay a percentage of net revenue from referred users for the lifetime of the account. Cam affiliate programs commonly advertise revshare in a wide range across the industry, but specific numbers shift with tier promotions, region, and traffic quality. Quoting a fixed percentage in a procurement review without verifying current dashboard terms is a small error that can become a large one if a campaign is built around it. Treat published numbers, including those in this paragraph, as cues to verify, not as quotes.

- Percentage of net revenue, lifetime
- Rates shift with tier and promotions
- Verify current revshare on the dashboard

### CPA or hybrid availability

CPA offers pay a fixed amount per qualifying action, often a verified signup or first token purchase, rather than ongoing revenue. CPA simplifies forecasting and front-loads revenue, but trades away long-tail income from valuable users. Hybrid combines a smaller CPA payment with a smaller revshare, smoothing risk for partners who run mixed traffic. Availability of each is partner-by-partner and can require approval from account management. The official affiliate FAQ is the source of truth.

- CPA: fixed amount per qualifying action
- Hybrid: smaller CPA plus smaller revshare
- Approval may be required for non-default offers

### Sub-affiliate terms

Sub-affiliate or referral-of-referrals tiers, where a partner earns a slice of revenue from affiliates they recruit, are common in cam programs. Verify whether sub-affiliate is currently active, the percentage, and any tier cap on the affiliate portal before relying on it.

*Revshare, CPA, and hybrid exist as categories; specific rates live on the dashboard.*

## How to Join

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**Joining the program involves applying through the partner portal, being approved by the affiliate team, and receiving tracking links plus creatives. The site you are reading has not enrolled, so this section is a procurement walkthrough, not a first-hand account.**

### Application and approval

Applications in adult cam programs typically ask for the traffic source, expected volume, geographic mix, and prior affiliate experience. Approval is not automatic. The affiliate team checks the application against compliance rules and traffic-quality expectations, and may request a sample of the publishing properties. Time to approval varies. For procurement, plan for review time rather than assuming instant onboarding. If the team requests more information, treat it as a normal step rather than a rejection signal.

- Application covers traffic source and volume
- Affiliate team reviews against compliance
- Approval is not instant

### Tracking links and creatives

Approved partners get access to tracking link generators, a creative library of banners and landing pages, and reporting that breaks out impressions, clicks, signups, and revenue events. Link parameters carry the affiliate identifier through the funnel so qualifying actions are attributed correctly. Test attribution from a private session before scaling, since a misconfigured link can lose weeks of clicks.

**Procurement note.** This site has not enrolled with the StripCash program. The walkthrough here is based on standard adult cam affiliate procedures and public-facing materials, not on dashboard access. Verify everything in the official portal.

### Compliance checks before promotion

Before sending traffic, confirm your traffic source is allowed for the offer, that your creatives match the program's brand rules, and that any required disclosures are in place. Compliance violations can void earnings even after the clicks fire.

*Apply, await approval, test attribution, only then scale.*

## Payouts and Payment Methods

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**Payouts in adult cam programs run on regular cycles with a minimum threshold and a list of payment methods that varies by region. Verify the current cycle, minimum, and method list on the affiliate dashboard.**

### Minimum payout and schedule

Most cam programs pay on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly cycle, with a minimum balance required to trigger release. The exact cycle and minimum for StripCash are set on the dashboard and can change with program updates. For procurement modeling, treat the cycle and minimum as inputs that affect cash-flow planning, not just trivia. A high minimum on a

slow-ramping traffic source can mean weeks before the first payout. Verify the current schedule before forecasting break-even on a campaign.

- Cycle is weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly
- Minimum balance triggers release
- Verify the current schedule on the dashboard

## **Bank, crypto, and wallet options**

Common payment methods in adult affiliate include bank wire, specialty wallets, prepaid cards, and crypto in supported regions. Each method has its own fee structure, processing window, and per-payout minimum, and not every method is available to every region. For partners outside major banking jurisdictions, crypto and wallets often provide the most reliable rails; for partners in major jurisdictions, bank wire is usually the cheapest at scale. The dashboard lists the methods enabled for your account.

- Bank wire, specialty wallets, prepaid cards, crypto
- Fees, windows, and floors vary by method
- Regional availability differs

## **Holds, refunds, and fraud checks**

Payouts can be held for fraud review, chargebacks, or unusual traffic patterns. Clean attribution, allowed traffic sources, and a stable referral mix reduce hold risk. Plan for the possibility of a hold rather than assuming every cycle clears on time.

*Cycle, minimum, methods, and hold policy all change. Verify before forecasting.*

## **Traffic Sources and Restrictions**

**Allowed traffic sources are spelled out in the program terms. SEO, paid media, social, email, and incentivized traffic each have their own rules, and violations void earnings even on otherwise valid clicks.**

### **SEO, paid, social, and email rules**

SEO traffic is generally allowed for editorial content that meets adult ad-network rules, with brand mentions handled carefully. Paid traffic typically requires the offer to be on networks that accept adult, with creatives that match the program's brand and disclosure rules. Social traffic is constrained by the platform: most large social networks do not allow adult content, so partners route through allowed networks or through bridge pages. Email lists must be opt-in and adult-compliant in the partner's jurisdiction. Read the program terms for the current allowed-source list.

- SEO with editorial content and careful brand mentions
- Paid on adult-friendly ad networks
- Social through allowed networks only
- Opt-in adult-compliant email lists

## Brand bidding and adult ad policies

Brand bidding, buying paid search on the program's own brand terms, is usually restricted or forbidden in cam affiliate programs because it cannibalizes the brand's direct traffic. Adult ad policies on the major networks also limit creative formats, disclaimers, and landing-page content. Confirm both the program's brand-bidding stance and the host network's adult policy before placing any spend on brand terms.

- Brand bidding usually restricted
- Network ad policies limit creatives
- Confirm both layers before spend

## Restricted regions to verify

Some regions are restricted at the platform level, and some traffic from those regions does not qualify for payouts. Regional restrictions evolve with regulation. Verify the current restricted region list on the affiliate dashboard before targeting paid media to specific geographies.

*Source rules, brand bidding, region list. All three move; verify on the dashboard.*

## Pros and Cons for Affiliates

**For a marketer evaluating cam affiliate offers, StripCash sits in the major-program tier with the trade-offs that implies: high-intent traffic and competitive offer structure against heavy competition and compliance load.**

### High-intent adult traffic

Adult cam search intent is high commercial intent: viewers searching for cam platforms are usually a few clicks from a token purchase. That makes well-attributed referrals valuable, especially under revshare, where the lifetime of a customer matters more than the first click. Stripchat's consumer brand has strong search visibility, which means publishers do not have to educate users about what the platform is before converting them. The intent quality is a structural advantage of the category.

- High commercial intent in cam search
- Short distance from click to token purchase
- Strong consumer brand reduces education cost

### Competition and compliance risk

The same intent quality means heavy competition for the same keywords and ad slots. Adult ad networks are smaller than mainstream ones, which concentrates bids and raises CPCs on competitive terms. Compliance risk is also higher: traffic-source rules, regional restrictions, and ad-network policies stack into a longer pre-launch checklist than a typical mainstream offer. For partners new to adult, the compliance learning curve can be the dominant factor in early performance.

### When another cam offer fits better

Premium cam offers like LiveJasmin or other freemium programs may fit better for traffic that converts on private shows or on specific category niches. Evaluating two or three offers in parallel during the first quarter is usually a better procurement decision than committing exclusively.

*Strong category fundamentals, heavy compliance load. Run a parallel pilot.*

## FAQ

### What commission models does StripCash offer?

Cam affiliate programs of this scale typically offer revshare, CPA, and hybrid structures, with rates set per offer and per partner. Specific percentages and CPA amounts are visible on the affiliate dashboard. This site has not enrolled, so verify current terms directly on the official affiliate portal.

### How do I join the Stripchat affiliate program?

Apply through the official partner portal, supplying traffic source, expected volume, and prior affiliate experience. The affiliate team reviews applications against compliance and traffic-quality expectations. Approval is not instant; plan for review time in any procurement timeline.

### What payment methods are available?

Common cam-program methods include bank wire, specialty wallets, prepaid cards, and crypto in supported regions. Availability depends on the partner's region and verification status. The dashboard lists the methods enabled for each account; verify there rather than from external lists.

### Is brand bidding allowed?

Brand bidding on the program's own terms is usually restricted in cam affiliate programs because it cannibalizes direct traffic. Confirm the current stance in the program terms before placing any paid-search spend on brand keywords.

### What traffic sources are allowed?

SEO, paid media on adult-friendly networks, opt-in email lists, and social through allowed networks are common categories. Incentivized traffic is generally forbidden. The program terms list the current allowed sources and any region-specific restrictions; verify before launching any campaign.

### Has this site enrolled with StripCash?
